This Spanish born DJ got the first taste of DJing when the 7 years old Pandez experimented with her mother's turntable player. Fast forward to many years after that, she started her DJing career in Miami and the rest is history. She is probably one of the few DJs that maintain the underground attitude of 'doing it out of passion, not because of money and fame' which we find pleasing. Read on.

Hi Sassy, how does it feels being a female DJ in a male dominated industry? Tell us about your early years of DJing?

It wasn't easy in the beginning, as people gave me a hard time. 10 years ago it was a totally different kind of underground scene unlike today. To avoid these problems, I dressed like a tomboy, with hoodie and trainers. People mistook me for a boy until they came close to the decks. Female DJs were really unheard of at that time. Back then I played lots of Wu-Tang Clan stuff. Now that I am an established DJ, I no longer receive such treatment. I love the time when hip-hop was underground, now it's all about money and fame.

You are compared to Cindy Crawford from time to time. Do you take it as a compliment or insult?

Yeah I got compared with so many people; Cindy Crawford, Eva Mendes, some people even said I got Angelina Jolie lips...but they never compare me to Grandmaster Flash!"laughs" I take it as a compliment but I try to tone it down when I'm DJing.

Have you ever got so drunk, that you can't play at all?

Occasionally I might drink, but because I tend to get drunk really fast I'm not into drinking anymore. And I don't take drugs. It's not good for your image when you are an established DJ but you can't play because you are drunk. I enjoy DJing so much and I don't want to ruin it. I try to stay healthy because I want to have a long career.

Describe yourself in three words.

Passionate, loyal and unpredictable. Loyal is the most important quality for my personality. Like when I give somebody my word or my trust, they have it for life no matter what.

How do you find The Sexiest DJ in the World fits you? Do you think you can live up to the reputation?

"Laughs" Come on! I don't know whether I want to. I had the title Best Female Hip-Hop DJ in the World way before that. I try to make people use it more on the flyers although some people prefer the latter. Well, I'm not trying to be sexy at all when I'm DJing, honestly.

You do both modeling and DJing at the same time. Which one of these represents you the most?

I just call myself a DJ. But recently I shot some campaigns, for instance Nelly's Apple Bottoms which is for the perfume line. It's kinda cool.

Where do you see yourself in 10 years time? Do you have any specific plan?

I want to DJ forever, I'd probably DJ until I die! It's a lifestyle for me. Well I might go into production but I'll always be a DJ, that's for sure. It's a priority, always will be.

Being a sexy DJ is sure gonna attract lots of male fans. Do you get harassed during your set? And how do you deal with that?

Most of my fans are female although I have male fans as well. Usually these men are footballers and the type that love pretty women, because my events attract lots of beautiful women "laughs". No I don't really get harassed by men. My male fans are well behaved. It's quite the opposite of what you think.

If you weren't into DJing, what would you do?

I might be a boxer. When I was seven I told my mom I wanted to be a boxer. She bought me a punch bag and I still have it. I was into kickboxing for a while, but I don't really do much kickboxing these days. I still have my boxing shorts at home. There's nothing like a good fight!"laughs"
